Kissimmee Police Department Launches New Citizen Communication Tool

Kissimmee, Fla. (October 2, 2007) – The Kissimmee Police Department is introducing a new email address that citizens can use to contact them to report suspicious activity. The email is SeeItSayIt@Kissimmee.org.

“Reporting information via a computer gives a sense of anonymity which makes some of our citizens more comfortable,” explains police spokesperson, Stacie Miller. “We are hoping that by launching this new tool, more citizens will get involved with community policing by reporting suspicious activity or even information on crimes that our investigators are trying to solve.”

When a citizen sends an email to SeeItSayIt@Kissimmee.org, they will receive an automated response that explains, as with all calls, the email will be prioritized and they maybe contacted with further questions. The mailbox will be checked frequently throughout the day and night.

“We do ask our citizens to continue to call 9-1-1 if a true emergency is occurring so we may send help immediately,” said Jean Moe, Communication Center Manager. “This email is just another step in bringing the community and police together to make Kissimmee a better place to live, work and visit.”
